TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Fees

- a) Lesson fees are subject to annual review. Where Lesson fees are increased as a result of such a review, the Teacher shall give the Student at least two months' notice of such increase.
- b) An invoice will be sent at the beginning of each month including said months lessons and the total must be paid upfront before lessons take place.

2. Lessons

- a) Lessons will take place once a week unless an alternative arrangement is mutually agreed. Statutory holidays do not apply and will require notice for cancellation.
- b) Any Lesson missed by the Student shall be paid for unless otherwise agreed with the Teacher or a minimum of 24 hours' notice to reschedule or cancel.
- c) Lessons are non-refundable. If the Teacher is unable to give any scheduled Lesson, the Lesson will be arranged for another date. If this is not possible, the Lesson fee will be reduced from the following invoice.
- d) If the Student is under 18, the Parent/Guardian gives permission for the Teacher to teach the Student
- e) Extra Lessons may be scheduled by mutual agreement and at a cost mutually agreed between the Student and the Teacher.

3. Termination of agreement

A decision to discontinue lessons may be taken by the Student/Parent/Guardian or the Teacher, in which case four weeks' written notice shall be given by the party seeking to discontinue. In the event that the Student discontinues Lessons with insufficient notice, the Student/Parent/Guardian will be liable to pay fees for those Lessons not taken during the notice period.

4. General

- a) The Student/Parent/Guardian agrees to pay for any music equipment required by the Student.
- b) The Student/Parent/Guardian will be responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any instrument, accessory or music equipment loaned by the Teacher to the Student.
- c) The Student/Parent/Guardian undertakes not to make photocopies of any music notation/material without direct authorization from the Teacher.
- d) The Teacher is not liable for any injuries or damages suffered by the Student.
- e) The Teacher must be informed of any medical or other condition affecting the Student.

This agreement is subject to the conditions printed above and may only be varied with the agreement of both parties.
